Next week marks the last week of the term and I would like to discuss the final arrangements for the term.

### CHILDREN NOT GOING ON CAMP

If your child is not going on camp, they are still required to attend school from the 7<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> April.

**Work has been scheduled for all children not attending camp.** The work will cover topics in English, Mathematics, Maths Literacy, Creative Arts and Study Skills. ## END OF TERM

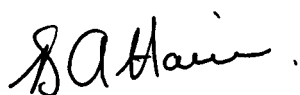
Please take note that school will be closed for Good Friday on the 3<sup>rd</sup> April as well as on the 6<sup>th</sup> April which is Family Day.
